**1. Welcome and Introductions**

Emily Lindsey, Chair, welcomed attendees to the Advanced Mobility Partnership (AMP) Working Group.

**2. Election of Vice-Chair**

Election of a Vice-Chair was postponed to a later meeting.

**3. AMP Focus Area: Data and Data Sharing**

*Action Item: Concept*

Ms. Lindsey walked the working group through the concept white paper<sup>1</sup> for a mobility data and data sharing platform. As presented at previous working group meetings, the platform

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is envisioned as a set of tools focused around four key components (discovering data, sharing and understanding data and methodologies, collecting and analyzing data, and managing and operating the transportation system). Working Group members were invited to participate in a survey of their thoughts related to the platform concept. The AMP partner agencies on the call voted to recommend the concept to the Executive Committee.

*Action Item: Next Steps*

Ms. Lindsey noted that next steps will be to bring recommendations for moving forward to the AMP Executive Committee. Through a survey, many participants expressed interest in an incremental approach focusing on the highest priority use cases, while keeping an eye on the eventual end state of the platform so that any incremental improvements were compatible with the final goal. Ms. Lindsey presented DRCOG's recommendation to move forward with developing a regional data governance structure and a concept of operations for the Discover and Share & Understand components. Other AMP partner agencies were invited to develop their own recommendations and coordinate with the Data and Data Sharing Subcommittee prior to the Executive Committee meeting.

**4. Partner Agency Updates and Other Matters**

Ms. Lindsey reminded working group members to provide edits and updates to the regional technology pilot tracker. Josh Schwenk, DRCOG, informed working group members about DRCOG's ongoing Transportation Improvement Program Calls for Projects, including the current Subregional Call for air quality and multimodal projects.<sup>2</sup> Ms. Lindsey also reminded partner agencies that the Executive Committee will next meet on June 1. Ms. Lindsey also informed working group members that AMP working group meetings will likely remain virtual for now, but occasional in-person site visits may be organized in the future.

**5. Next Meeting and Adjournment**

Ms. Lindsey thanked everyone for participating in the meeting. The next meeting is June 7, 2022.

### SUMMARY

DRCOG, with key regional stakeholders, is completing a Regional Transportation Operations & Technology (RTO&T) Strategic Plan. The development of the “operational concept” for regional transportation day-to-day operations was reviewed with the working group at the April meeting. The operational concept builds from planning guidance provided in the DRCOG Metro Vision Plan and the Mobility Choice Blueprint echoing the theme of collaborative, integrated and regional operations.

To advance regional transportation day-to-day operations, several initiatives have been identified that address the transition from existing operations to those described in the operational concept. This presentation will provide an overview of those initiatives.

This strategic plan will provide guidance for the upcoming call-for-projects for the RTO&T Set-Aside. The call for projects is scheduled to follow early in 2023. AMP partner agency staff will continue to be updated on the progress and implementation of the plan through engagement with the AMP Working Group.
